### TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Registration is subject to receipt of a non-refundable registration fee. For participants who complete the online registration form on or before 20<sup>th</sup> June, this registration fee is £150, and for participants who complete the online registration form after 20<sup>th</sup> June, this registration fee is £250.
- If you have selected the flight option, you agree to pay Mara Foundation £585 for this at the time you register. The reserved flights will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.
- Each participant must raise the minimum sponsorship, of which 80% must be received by the Mara Foundation before 6<sup>th</sup> October 2010 [12 weeks prior to event] and the remainder before 1<sup>st</sup> December 2010 [4 weeks prior to event]. The minimum sponsorship levels are determined by the participant's age at the start date of Cycle4Uganda, as follows:
  - 12—16 years: £1,300
  - 17—20 years: £1,800
  - 21 years+: £2,300
- If the event is cancelled, or if a participant is unable to ride, the Mara Foundation is not obliged to make any refund. Please make sure your travel insurance covers you in case of cancellation.
- The family discount advertised applies only to immediate relatives (i.e. husband/wife, mother/father, son/daughter, brother/sister). The discount will be applied in age order, with the youngest member of the family receiving the greatest discount. The Mara Foundation reserves the right to assess eligibility for this discount on a case by case basis.
- If you are unable to meet the sponsorship requirements you will forfeit your place on the event.
- All funds raised should be made payable to "Cycle4Uganda – JCT".
- Participants under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- You must have a valid visa for Uganda (you will be advised on how to obtain this in advance).
- The names you give on this registration form must match the names on your passport, otherwise you may incur significant additional charges.
- Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months from your date of return to your country of residence.
- You must have adequate insurance for this challenge, which should cover you in case of cancellation, and you must inform the Mara Foundation of your insurance provider's name, your policy number and their 24 hour emergency number by 6<sup>th</sup> October 2010.
- It is a requirement that you must provide and wear a suitable cycle helmet at all times whilst cycling on this challenge.
- You accept that all instructions given to you on the challenge must be observed for your own safety.
- If you have any medical conditions which may be affected by strenuous activity, or you are over 60, you must get written clearance from your doctor. By submitting this form, you confirm that your general state of health and fitness is good and you take full responsibility for yourself.
- Participants enter the event entirely at their own risk, and shall have no claim whatsoever against the Mara Foundation or Action Challenge, in respect of any damage, harm or loss suffered at, during or as a consequence of the event, including, but not limited to, damage, harm or loss to property, or damage, harm or loss arising out of the death or illness of, or injury to, any person or party.
